Creating a sense of community at school takes more than just students and teachers. The SeeBeyondBorders School Development Planning program seeks to stimulate collaboration from parents, teachers and community members in agreeing and working to implement their vision for their school.

Working in stages, SeeBeyondBorders establishes a school development team of community representatives and builds their capacity and skills; assists the school community in the process of visioning and planning; stimulates community interest and involvement; provides support to school development team members in ways of financing and implementing their goals; and supports schools in an ongoing process of monitoring, evaluating and refining the implementation of their school development plans.

This program is pivotal in ensuring ownership and responsibility at the local level. By creating a sense of pride and self-belief our communities are able to identify and implement improvements for future generations.

Our Impact: 2015

In 2015, SeeBeyondBorders launched a pilot School Development Program in 4 schools across the Bavel and Angkor Thom districts. The meetings have been attended by 446 members of the community, with all schools agreeing and committing to the implementation of a school development plan.

But having better schools is only part of the solution. As well as addressing the challenges of **access** to improved facilities through programs like this one, SeeBeyondBorders also works to improve **attendance** levels and gives **attention** to the *quality* of education delivered by Cambodian teachers.
